



New Jersey Mosquito Control Association, Inc. Guidelines for Poster Submissions

The New Jersey Mosquito Control Association holds a poster competition each year during the annual meeting. We encourage everyone to enter a poster regarding any subject that may be interesting to the mosquito control community. Please see the below rules and guidelines for more specific information.

No specific size is required; however the majority of submitted posters are 48" x 36".

Please supply 8.5" x 11" handouts (smaller version of the poster, or bullet points of pertinent info). Feel free to bring along props or items to showcase.

- ◆ Posters will be accepted from everyone.
- ◆ Posters may be opted-out of the competition if the author so chooses.
- ◆ Industry posters are in-eligible for the competition *if* it is a sales-driven poster, and not based on research.
- ◆ You must be present beside your poster during the poster session for Q&A.
- ◆ Each poster is judged by a panel of judges (as selected by the poster competition coordinator(s)). The standards on which the posters are judged are based on the criteria as follows: 1. poster appearance, 2. clear and concise message, 3. benefit/value to the mosquito control community, & 4. knowledge of the subject.

2nd place: \$50

3rd place: \$25
